The secretary presents his report and the financial statements for the period ended 31 January 2017.

#### **Principal activity**

The principal activity of the fund is the provision of funding for local community causes.

For the first year £30,000 was made available to the fund. Of this amount, £14,989 was paid out in respect of applications received from members of the community.

As at the balance sheet date applications for a further £13,537 had been approved by the Benefit Fund Panel. This amount breaks down as follows: restoration of lamp on square in Ince village centre £2,350, purchase of play equipment for 3-7 year olds for playground in Ince £5,987 and footpath creation and access improvements £5,200 around Ince Village Hall.
